1. CALL TO ORDER, MAYOR CHRIS VINCENT

Mayor Chris Vincent called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. Also present were Vice Mayor Alfred “Buz” Oldaker, Commissioner Edmund Malkoon, Commissioner Elliot Sokolow, Commissioner Randy Strauss, Town Attorney Susan Trevarthen, Town Manager Linda Connors, Assistant to the Town Manager Neysa Herrera, Development Services Director Jhanelle Campbell, Public Works Director Ken Rubach, and Special Events and Marketing Manager Debbie Hime.

3. NEW BUSINESS

a. Certification of Election Results

Assistant to the Town Manager Neysa Herrera recalled that the Town held its municipal election on March 8, 2022, which involved two seats on the Town Commission. The results of this election have been canvassed by the Broward County Canvassing Board in accordance with Florida Statute Section 102.1.41. The Broward Supervisor of Elections has provided the certified election results, which reelected Commissioner Randy Strauss and elected Commissioner Theo Pouloupoulos.

Vice Mayor Oldaker made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Malkoon, to accept the results. Motion carried 5-0.

Mayor Vincent read a Proclamation in honor of outgoing Town Commissioner Elliott Sokolow upon his many years of public service.

At this time Mayor Vincent opened public comment.

Ron Piersante, resident, recognized Commissioner Sokolow’s service to Lauderdale-By-The-Sea and its residents.

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Ann Marchetti, resident, thanked Commissioner Sokolow for his dedication and service to the Town.

With no other individuals wishing to speak at this time, Mayor Vincent closed public comment.

Commissioner Sokolow thanked the members of the public, Staff, and other Commissioners for their comments, and wished new Town Commissioner Theo Pouloupoulos well in his position. He also recognized Broward County Vice Mayor Lamar Fisher for his assistance over the years.

b. Oath of Office

Assistant to the Town Manager Herrera administered the Oath of Office to the reelected and newly elected Mayor and Commissioners.

c. Personal Code of Conduct for the Town Commission

Assistant to the Town Manager Herrera recalled that in 2010, the Town Commission established a Personal Code of Conduct for themselves and have signed this document whenever a new Commissioner is seated. It is available online for any individuals who wish to review it. The Mayor and Commissioners signed the Code of Conduct at this time.

Commissioner Pouloupoulos thanked the citizens of the Town for the opportunity to serve in public office.

Commissioner Strauss also thanked the Town's citizens for their support and stated that the Commission would continue the path it has taken over the last four years.

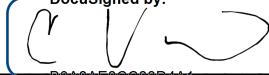
Mayor Vincent thanked the Town for the opportunity to continue serving its residents as Mayor and looked forward to the next two years.
