NOTICE OF VIRTUAL 1ST PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING

Pursuant to Executive Order 20-69 issued by the Governor and the Town Local Declaration of Public Emergency, a VIRTUAL Town Commission meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 14, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. and broadcast from Town Hall.

The September 14, 2020 1ST public budget hearing will be held as a VIRTUAL MEETING with elected officials and Town staff participating through video conferencing. This virtual meeting will be broadcasted live for members of the public to view on the Town's website (www.lbts-fl.gov), Comcast Channel 78, and AT&T U-verse Channel 99.

The Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Town Commission welcomes and encourages the public to participate at its virtual meetings and offers two ways for residents to be heard.

Please provide us with your name email address and phone number. We will then send you the Zoom Meeting ID and link. For security reasons, please do not share the Meeting ID with anyone else. If a friend or neighbor also wishes to speak, have them sign-up with the Town Clerk.

When contacting the Town Clerk, please specify if you wish to speak during Public Comments or during a specific agenda item. The Town will enable the Waiting Room function on Zoom and allow public speakers to enter the virtual meeting during Public Comments or for a specific agenda item. You can join the meeting either by calling in or using a laptop, computer webcam or cell phone. Once you are finished commenting, the Town will disconnect you from the meeting.

Please note that Governor DeSantis's Executive Order Number 20-69 suspended the requirements of Section 286.011, Florida Statutes, the Florida Sunshine law, that a quorum be present and that a local government body meet at a specific public place. The Executive Order also allows local government bodies to utilize communications media technology, such as telephonic and video conferencing for local government body meetings.

Should any person desire to appeal any decision of the Town Commission with respect to any matter to be considered at this meeting, that person shall ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made including all testimony and evidence upon which any appeal may be based (Section 286.0105, Fla. Stat).

PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Public Comments may address issues that are not on this meeting's agenda, but should relate to the business of the Town, and should not contain personal attacks. If your comment requires follow up, the Town Manager will have a staff person respond to your concerns, and will advise us of the outcome.

The Town Clerk will read off the names of those who have signed up to speak. When your name is called, please come to the podium, state your name for the record, and indicate whether you are a Town resident. Do not state your address. You have up to three minutes to make your comments, but there is no requirement to use the entire time. If you wish to address a particular Commissioner or member of Town Administration, please do so by use of their title.

If you wish to approach the Commission dais to hand out a document or for some other reason, please request permission and state your reason for doing so. All documents to be provided to the Commission should be handed to the Town Clerk for distribution.

These procedures have been developed to assure that the Town Commission meeting time is efficiently used, and that meetings are conducted in a polite and respectful manner. More information on the decorum rules for Town Commission meetings is available in Section 2-23 of the Town Code of Ordinances.
